Khadilkar ,Secretary, age 63 years, hereinafter called as Party No. 1 and/(or) "Vidyapeeth" (which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof shall mean and includes his/her/their heirs, successors, executors, assigns, administrators, etc.)

Here in after called as Party of the second part and/ (or) "Hospital" (which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof shall mean and includes his/her/their heirs, successors, executors, assigns, administrators, etc.)

- 03. Whereas, The Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth has established a college of Nursing course in 2008 in the name, Institute of Nursing Education and Research. With appropriate permissions from Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi. Maharashtra Nursing Council, Govt.of Maharashtra and affiliated university.
- 04. While giving the clinical training we require well equipped Hospital having multi speciality having the capacity of 500 beds, whereas the party of second party running a Multi Speciality Hospital in Chinchwad, Pune area more than 14 years and having the capacity of 500 beds and the infrastructure required for requisite training to the students of Nursing course. The party of the Second part has agreed to give the co-operation to the party of the First part for providing clinical training to the students regularly under certain terms and conditions which have been mutually agreed by and between the parties.
- 05. As per the MOU the Party of the Second Part shall provide clinical / hospital training to the students from, Institute of Nursing Education and Research, Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth, Pune for a period of 5 years and the Party of the First Part shall sent Nursing students for the purpose of training and experience to the hospital of the Party of the Second Part. The Party of the Second Part hereby assures to provide the said training to the Nursing course without any interruption. Party of the Second Party if due to any reasons unable to provide such training in their hospital, then in such case the Party of the Second Part shall give the full co-operation for making alternative arrangement for training to the students of the Party of the First Part on the same terms and conditions.





06. STUDENTS TO BE PLACED / OR CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

Nursing students will be sent from the time period 2021-2022 and it will be continued till 5 Years

07. HOURS OF PLACEMENT IN THE CLINICAL AREAS

The nursing students will be posted as per curriculum prescribed by Indian Nursing Council and Vidyapeeth expect during holidays of the Vidyapeeth vacation an examination and for any other institutional activities

08. CLINICAL AREAS

a) The students of the Nursing course shall be receiving training in Medical, Surgical and Orthopedic Wards, gynecology and obstetrics, ICU, CCU, Dermatology wards, Pediatric (medical, surgical and intensive care) and OPDs. Oncology, Cardiology, Neurology, Endocrinology, Nephrology, Disorders, Deficiency and communicable diseases etc. and other specialized units as per INC (Indian Nursing Council) norms.

All the students in every wards and OPDs, etc. would be accompanied by their supervisors on the wards for guiding, teaching and demonstrating nursing procedures to the students. No students will be left in any ward or department without being supervised by the supervisor appointed for that purpose by the Foundation.

Rotation of students will be planned as per prescribed syllabus in consultation with the Nursing Superintendent of the Hospital.

09. INSPECTION

The authorities appointed by the Government for the purpose of inspecting the Clinical Specialties for the Nursing Programmers as under:

- a) Indian Nursing Council
- b) Maharashtra Nursing Council
- c) State Government
- d) University
- e) Any other authority

These authorities shall inspect the clinical facilities in the course duration of the programme of Nursing course and then from time to time for recognition of the programme. So as per the statutory body norms hospital shall co-operate for the inspection with required documents.



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10. DEMOGRAPHIC DATA OF THE HOSPITAL

The demographic data of the hospital are required to be furnished in the Vidyapeeth application to the Governing Council if required.

11. ASSISTANCE FROM HOSPITAL

The Hospital Nursing, Medical and Paramedical personnel shall assist the students of the Vidyapeeth in Clinical Teaching as and when found necessary and shall guide the students as per hospital policies and routine.

The Hospital allows to Students for usage of hospital equipments and supplies for nursing care of patients and its guidance and cooperation shall be given by the hospital personnel.

The Hospital shall not be responsible for any act of medical negligence or any other negligence of any of the students of the Vidyapeeth.

12. CONSIDERATION

For the purpose of making the hospital available for training to the students and for providing clinical facilities to the students of the Vidyapeeth it is here by understood between the parties that the Vidyapeeth shall compensate (Refer Annexure -1)

13. TERMINATION

In case this understanding not viable to the parties here to for any reasons what so ever, the party shall be liberty to terminate this MOU by giving one month notice in advance in writing to the other party after completion of academic year.

14. CONFIDENTIALITY

All terms and conditions of this Agreement and any materials provided during the term of the Agreement must be kept confidential by the Students and Vidyapeeth, unless the disclosure is required pursuant to process of law.

Disclosing or using this information for any purpose beyond the scope of this Agreement, or beyond the exceptions set forth above, is expressly forbidden without the prior consent of the Hospital.

15. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The Students and Vidyapeeth agrees that any intellectual property provided to him/her by the Hospital will remain the sole property of the Hospital,

- In case any damage or loss to the Hospital equipments through any students, the Vidyapeeth will be obliged to make good the same in totality. The decision of Hospital shall be final in this regard.

CLINICAL AREAS:

Clinical hours will be attended as per INC & MUIIS Norms

- b) The Students of the Second year B.Sc. Nursing shall be receiving training in wards having patients with Medical, Surgical and Orthopedic Oncology, Cardiology, Neurology, Endocrinology, Nephrology, Disorder, Deficiency and Communicable diseases and OPDs and Physiotherapy unit.
- c) Orthopedic, ICU, CCU, Dermatology wards, Pediatric (Medical, Surgical and intensive care) and OPDs.
- d) As an educational part, students may be posted in the hospital of party of second part, in day shift and night shift also.

All the Students on every wards and OPDs, etc. would be accompanied by their supervisors on the ward for guiding, teaching and demonstrating nursing procedures to the students. No students will be left in any ward or department without being supervised by the appointed faculty member for that purpose by the Foundation.

Rotation plan in concern with Chief Nursing Officer(CNO) and as per M.U.H.S. Norms of students will be planned in consultation with the nursing service Department of the Hospital i.e.

INSPECTION


The authorities appointed by the Government for the purpose of inspecting the clinical specialties for the B.Sc. Nursing Programmes as under:

For the purpose of making the hospital available for training to the students and for providing clinical facilities of the students of the Institute of Nursing Education and Research, Pune it is here be understood between the parties that the Party of the First Part shall compensate "The Hospital" and pay as per Annexure.

In case this understanding not viable to the parties here to for any reasons what so ever, the party shall be liberty to terminate this MOU by giving one month notice in advance in writing to the other part after completion of academic year.

Notwithstanding any of the conditions stated above the University and the Hospital shall work in unison vis-à-vis the students learning experience with mutual consent.


In case any damage or loss to the hospital through any students, the Party of the First Part will legal obligation to make good the same in totality. The decision of Hospital shall be final in this regard.
